NOTES TO PHYSICIAN:

This product is a pyrethroid. If large amounts have been ingested, the stomach and intestine should be evacuated. Treatment is symptomatic and supportive. Digestible fats, oils, or alcohol may increase absorption and so be avoided.

## SECTION 9 - SPILL, LEAK & DISPOSAL INFORMATION

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Avoid contact with spills. Keep unprotected people, pets and other animals away from spills. Confine liquid spills by diking with an absorbent material such as cat litter or clay. Cover spills of treated dry materials to prevent contact and dispersion. Put damaged packages into a suitable container large enough to hold the entire package and be appropriately sealed.
